MEMORANDUM FOR DESIGNATED FEDERAL OFFICER—DEFENSE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
ON INVESTIGATION, PROSECUTION, AND DEFENSE OF SEXUAL
ASSAULT IN THE ARMED FORCES

SUBJECT: Federal Register Notice Waiver

Your request to waive the Federal Register 15-calendar day meeting notification required by the Government in the Sunshine Act of 1976 (5 U.S.C. § 552b) for the September 14, 2019 meeting of the Defense Advisory Committee on Investigation, Prosecution, and Defense of Sexual Assault in the Armed Forces (“the Panel”) is approved.

The following statement shall be included in the Panel’s published Federal Register notice:

“Due to circumstances beyond the control of the Department of Defense (DoD) and the Designated Federal Officer, the Defense Advisory Committee on Investigation, Prosecution, and Defense of Sexual Assault in the Armed Forces was unable to provide public notification required by 41 C.F.R. § 102-3.150(a) concerning the rescheduling of its September 12, 2019 meeting to September 14, 2019 of the Defense Advisory Committee on Investigation, Prosecution, and Defense of Sexual Assault in the Armed Forces. Accordingly, the Advisory Committee Management Officer for the Department of Defense, pursuant to 41 C.F.R. § 102-3.150(b), waives the 15-calendar day notification requirement.”
